
How to read your Scholars Online invoice, and pay for membership, registration and tuition by check, Zelle, or by using our secure online PayPal Feature

Scholars Online allows you to pay for membership, registration, and tuition by check, PayPal account (including using your own credit card), or Zelle transfer. All fees are due according to the <u>Tuition and Fees</u> schedule on the of the website. Membership fees must be paid before members (parents and students) will be allowed access to the Moodle. Registration and tuition must be paid before students are allowed to attend chats for their courses.

Your invoice for the current enrollment year is always available on our secure website from your Account Management Center.

If enrollment is open for the new year but you are paying for a tutorial or have arranged a payment schedule into the school year, your invoice for the current year will display separately with payment options.

If you were a member in a previous enrollment year, your past invoices will also be available from the "Summary Invoice" button.



The online invoice has three major sections:

- Current charges and credits for membership, registration, and enrollments, listed by member, and total amount currently due for the member
- Payment history and credits applied as scholarships or teacher waivers, or for Early Bird registration.
- Total fees, registration, and tuition due for the year, all credits and payments applied, and outstanding amount left.

Payment Options

Payment options

You may pay three different ways:

1) You may pay using Zelle directly to the Scholars Online account (preferred method).

2) You may mail a check to Scholars Online.

3) You may use PayPal. The PayPal options will vary depending on whether or not you have already paid membership and registration and part of tuition, and whether you are paying in installments. Our installment policy has changed...read on!

Note that we do not store any of your financial account information (banking accounts, credit card numbers) in our database. All transactions are handled securely by your bank or PayPal.

- 2. Courses for which the student has requested enrollment are listed, with the original tuition amount and any credits and payments applied directly to this amount.
- 3. If a member has enrollments listed, the invoice will also show the status of registration fees.
- 4. Each member's credits and outstanding amounts course tuition will be shown for each course.
- 5. Total unpaid charges for all members is listed as the "Account total due: below the individual member charges area.

Payment and credits history

- 1. Payments received from you will be listed by date and time processed by the Accounts manager). Type will show as check, Zelle, or PayPal. How the payment was applied to individual student memberships, registrations, or course tuitions will also be noted.
- 2. Individual teacher contractors, or the Scholars Online administration, may grant tuition waivers. The SO Board of Directors also grants scholarships to students based on demonstrated financial need. All non-payment credits will be listed in the Special Credits section, and applied as offsets to individual classes. In this case, no scholarships or teacher waivers were awarded.

Payment options:

3. Use PayPal

If you wish to use a credit card or your PayPal account, click on the PayPal Checkout button. We no longer offer predetermined installment amounts or designer amount payments, since these are more easily handled with Zelle.

Note that unless you have made specific arrangements with the Accounts office for installment payments after the start of classes, you must pay all fees prior to the start of the session. Please contact accounts@scholarsonline.org if you need to make such arrangements.

How do I know you've received my payment?

- 1. If you pay using Zelle, your payment should be confirmed by your bank within a few minutes, and we will receive notification of the payment.
- 2. If you pay using PayPal, you will receive an email from PayPal containing the amounts and fees paid as soon as you complete your transaction. We will receive the same information.
- 3. When we receive your payment by Zelle, PayPal, or check, we will manually update your invoice information at your account management center to ensure that your membership fees, registration fees, and tuition payments are properly assigned.

Note that crediting your account is not an automated process. We review every payment to ensure that you receive proper credit, especially if there are special circumstances, such as installment payments, or you have received teacher credits or scholarships.. While we try to be as timely as possible, during peak enrollment periods, this action may take up to 2 days after we receive your check or notification of payment. If we have any questions about your payment, we will contact you to verify proper distribution of your funds against your outstanding fees.

You will receive a confirmation email showing when your payment was processed and how it was distributed as soon as we update your invoice data.

What if I need a refund?

- 1. Membership fees and registration fees are not refundable. Your membership remains in place for the entire year, and you have access to the Moodle and open classes we offer.
- 2. The amount of any tuition refund is determined by the tuition and fees refund policy published on our website.
- 3. If you paid using PayPal and request your refund within 60 days, we will refund the appropriate amount through PayPal. If you paid by Zelle or by check, Scholars Online will send a check to the address we have on record.
