How to use your Scholars Online, Chat, and Moodle logins to find your courses, attend class, and submit work

You can log into your own student account from the Scholars Online Account option, and into class session chats from the "Chat Access option on the Scholars Online Home Page. You can log into the Moodle from the Moodle Access option. You may want to bookmark these pages, especially if you log into them from a tablet.



Select the login tab from the Menu on any Scholars Online site page.

Select the Scholars Online Account option to look at your schedule, texts, and transcript.

Scroll down and click on the "Live Class Access" option to get to the Scholars Online Chat list for the day, or to Chat Logs.

Scroll down and click on the "Moodle Access" option to get to the Scholars Online Moodle.

Your Scholars Online member account contains your transcript, textbook, and schedule information. If you are under 18, you cannot change your personal information (name, address, email); these must be changed from your sponsor's account.

Students use the Chat Login page to list their chats for the day. If no chat sessions are schedule, they can still get to the logs of past chat sessions for their classes.

When you first log into your Moodle Home Page, you'll see a lot of information at the top about the Moodle and the school. We use this space to publish important announcements, such as the Moodle upgrade outages, policy commitment deadlines, and important meeting or enrollment information. Whenever you log in, you should

quickly check this area for any new announcements.





The Moodle will look a bit different, depending on which device you use.

If you are using a tablet like an iPad or a smartphone, the course menu option may look like a set of three bars in on the left side of the page.

There is also a little arrow tab in the right of your screen. Click on this tab to list the options to display extra options for the page you are on.

These will be different for your home page, a course page, or an activity.

Click again to close it once you have made your choice.



At the upper right next to your name are two icons indicating alerts from the system (the bell) and messages from other Moodle users (the cartoon bubble). If you have messages waiting, there will be a number in red next to the bubble.

On the left side of your you'll find a calendar with dates marked if you have any events happening that day.

The upcoming events list warns you of impending tests or assignment due in the next few days. Here, you can see that mycroft (who is enrolled in a lot of science classes, obviously) has tests that will be available shortly in Natural Science and Pre-Chemistry.



Your Dashboard is always accessible from the top of your navigation list.

It will show files you have stored, upcoming event, recently accessed pages (very useful if you got sidetracked and need to get back quickly to some page you were on, and a very extensive calendar listing all the site-wide and course-specific deadlines that apply to you. You can add your own personal events (which only you can see), so you can use the Moodle as a centralized planning platform for all your coursework, not just your Scholars Online courses.

You can find the courses you were working on most recently...and perhaps most useful of all is your personal timeline, which will list assignments you need to finish (mycroft has a bunch of overdue work here for attention today, September 21, 2023). The timeline helps you stay focused on what you need to do today to complete work that is due on time.

The Moodle keeps track of information about you, your courses, and any activity you do in the Moodle, including logins, messages, assignments. You can look at your profile by clicking on your name in the upper right of the toolbar to get a dropdown menu. You can also check for calendar events, messages, look up your grades, and log out from here.

Clicking on your name will take you to your profile page and helpful links, including links to blog entries or forum posts you have made, and reports on grades for work tracked in the Moodle (which may not be the actual grade in the course, depending on what other assignments your teacher is using for evaluation), and a list of your current courses.



You can edit your profile by clicking on the Edit profile link in the User details box.



There are a couple of caveats about changing your profile.

You cannot change your username, since this is linked to the information in the primary Scholars Online site.

You can try to change your name and email address, but these will be resynchronized with the primary database as soon as you log in, so the only way to permanently change your email address is to change from the parent account in the Scholars Online members database. This ensures that email accounts are set up in accordance with Scholars Online's procedures, so that parents can monitor student email at their discretion.

One thing you can and should change here is your preferred timezone. By default, the account is set to the server timezone (the server is in Seattle, so this is Pacific Standard or Daylight Time, whichever is in effect). Change this value to your current timezone, and all test closure and assignment due dates will display correctly for your local time, rather than PST or PDT. This may help you avoid turning an assignment in late!

You can add a small avatar that will display with your name in some screens, and you can add a personal description and information about your interests. Your teachers and students in your classes will see this information.

What you find on your course page will depend on what features of the Moodle your teacher has chosen to use for a particular course, so your course pages may look different from these.

This is mycroft's Natural Science 2 course. The teacher has chosen to add some blocks like Upcoming Events and a Calendar. There's also some general information at the top of the course, and forums for announcements , news, and for students to post questions about the topic.

Scrolling down mycroft's Natural Science 2 Course home page, we get to sections tagged with the week of the course. The first two weeks have links to an outside website with information the student is expected to read before chat.

There is a forum (marked by a cartoon balloons) for students to introduce themselves in the first week.

There are some other activities (marked by a pencil and paper) that require the student's attention, and you can easily see that mycroft has completed the tasks for the introduction assignment, but has not viewed or submitted work for the mastery exercises.. ✓ 3 September - 9 September

Use the links in the Activities block to get to lists of all of your course Assignments, Forums, and Quizzes or Exercises, with due dates, whether you have completed the activity, and your grade. This will help you stay current with any activities due for the course.



Selecting the Participants link for the course will give you a list of the other students and teachers for this course. You can click on names in this list to send messages to one or all of your fellow students, which can be useful if you have cooperative projects that you need to work on, or to your teacher, if you have any questions about the course.





You can log out from your username at the top right of the page, but also from the bottom of any page.

Yes...we now support the mobile app for iOS and Android (but we think our mobile theme is prettier).



Clicking on the question mark next to some features will take you to the Moodle documentation for that item. Remember that this will be general documentation explaining how most Moodle sites work.

If you have any problems with our Moodle, send a message or email to the Production Administrator (that's Dr. Christe), with a description, the exact wording of the error message, and a screen shot, if possible.

The Moodle has many more features...this should help you get started finding your courses, assignments, quizzes, fellow students, and your teachers.
